Because of donors like you, we sheltered more than 1,750 individuals in 2023. These individuals included men, women, and families who came to us when they had nowhere else to turn. At no cost, our guests had the chance to take over 21,000 showers and complete over 3,800 loads of laundry. Families everywhere are struggling, but our CASA kids have endured more trauma and pain than any child should ever have to. With your help, we are ensuring they will not have to experience additional trauma. Our advocates are championing moms and dads to make positive changes for their children, and supporting children while they are waiting in foster homes for a more permanent plan. Our goal as a program is always reunification but moms and dads must be willing to put their kiddos first. Our volunteers are the eyes and ears for the Judge helping to tell a complete story. However, we are currently unable to appoint a volunteer for all the children we are assigned. We *always* have children with their families on our waitlist, which continues to grow as more abused children enter the foster care system. Currently, we are only able to provide advocates for about half the children assigned to the CASA Program.
