Icy Strait Point is located on Chichagoff Island, home to more brown bears than humans, where eagles soar overhead and whales are regularly seen just offshore. Experience the true Alaskan wilderness as you are surrounded by rainforest and mist-shrouded mountains. Explore a restored 1912 salmon cannery and museum, nature trails, and even a beach! Icy Strait Point is the port for adventure. Glide down the world's largest ZipRider, whale watch in the waters of Port Frederick and Point Adolphus, search for the coastal brown bears, or soar high above it all in a helicopter.

Ketchikan is set at the southernmost entrance to Alaska's famed Inside Passage with a network of waterways that snake through some of the most spectacular wilderness in the world. It is best known for three things: Feisty salmon, idyllic scenery, and an incredibly rich Alaskan Native culture. From here you can visit Misty Fjords National Monument by seaplane or boat. This 2.3 million-acre park is stunning, with massive glacial cliffs and secluded bays. Other popular excursions include Totem Heritage Center with its collection of over 30 totems dating back to the 19th century, fishing expeditions, hiking, and kayaking.

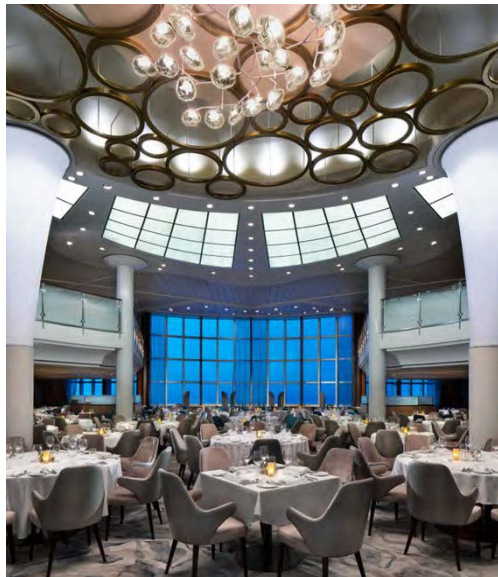
