## Trip cancellation & trip interruption

Protect travel investments and recover nonrefundable prepaid costs if your trip is canceled or interrupted for a covered reason. Popular covered reasons include:

- Sickness, injury, or death1
- Residence or destination uninhabitable
- Strike
- · Inclement weather
- · Cancel for business reasons
- · Traffic accident en route

#### Travel delay
