COVID EFFECT ON FRAUD

When the pandemic's stay-at-home orders ground everything to a halt, the impact hit credit and debit card users. Credit and debit cards fueled digital transactions. As consumers shifted their purchasing to mobile and online payments, criminals were right behind them. According to some estimates, around one-third of U.S. consumers were affected by fraud during the pandemic. Alarmingly, almost 80% of all U.S. fraudulent transactions are Card Not Present (CNP) transactions.

What can you do to fight CNP fraud
The increase in CNP fraud has heightened the need to
step up efforts to identify and combat all fraud.

- Educate yourself about the risks of CNP fraud. Be aware of CNP activity and the importance of closely monitoring credit card charges and statements in a timely manner.
- 2. Be aware of fake websites designed to mimic legitimate organizations. Be mindful of the rising sophistication level of these phishing efforts. It has become increasingly challenging to differentiate imposter sites from legitimate ones. As these instances increase, be diligent about your security measures by checking things such as a website URL and its contact page to ensure its legitimacy. Blatant spelling and grammar errors are often a sign that the site is fake.
- 3. Keep a constant eye on unusual activity in your accounts. While this may seem obvious, reviewing on a regular basis will put you at ease monitor by using your digital banking app and setting up alerts on your accounts.

CNP fraud has been around for many years. Yet, the high adoption of digital payments over the past 24 months has increased this fraud to new heights. You can fight this. Timely reminders can help you stay safe.
