Head Rules

Official

Rules Committee

Official rulings can only be made by a member of the Rules Committee listed above. They will be on the course for assistance should you need a ruling. If a rules official is not immediately available, and there is doubt as to the procedure, a second ball may be played. (See "Doubt as to Procedure" and follow accordingly.)

Net Double Bogey Max – Net Only!

In an attempt to speed up play, amateurs may "pick up" after reaching a score of NET Double Bogey on a hole. This is the maximum NET score a player can have on a hole. If a player is competing for overall gross, you MUST finish out the hole, there is not a maximum score for gross only.

Limitation on Golf Balls — "The One Ball Rule"

Titleist? Bridgestone? Nike? Play whatever ball you like, heck we encourage you to try a number of manufacturers. The One Ball Rule is NOT in effect for the amateurs in the Pro Am Jam.

Pace of Play

- Each player is responsible for playing without undue delay. (Rule 5.6b)
- Under normal conditions, all groups are expected to complete play of 9 holes in 2 hours, 15 minutes, and 18 holes in 4 hours, 30 minutes.
- A group is determined to be out of position if it has a clear hole ahead, and finishes a hole more than 14 minutes after the group in front of them.

If you have a rules question while on the course, play two balls.

Group Out of Position

- A group that is out of position will automatically be under official warning. A verbal warning is not required for a group to be under official warning.
- If a group is out of position, it is subject to timing under the Pro Am Jam Pace of Play policy. Any player taking an excess of 40 seconds to play a given shot on two occasions except in extraordinary circumstances shall incur a one-stroke penalty for delay of play on the first offense. There will be a two-stroke penalty on the second offense. Subsequent offenses will result in disqualification. (Rule 6-7)
- The final groups (Tournament Leaders) are expected to abide by the same pace of play procedures as the rest of the field.

Ties

In the event of a tie for the overall Low Gross or Net Champion on Saturday, a sudden death playoff will take place immediately following play on Saturday night.

In the event of a tie for 1st place in either flight of the Team Competition, or for 1st place within an individual flight, the winner will be determined using the following tiebreakers:

1. Team or individual total score from the final 18-hole round
2. Team or individual total score from the back 9 on the final round
3. Team or individual total score from holes #13-18 in the final round
4. Team or individual total score from holes #16-18 in the final round

All other tying positions for shop certificates will be divided equally.

Doubt as to Procedure

A competitor may play a second ball if the competitor is doubtful of his rights or procedure and a rules official is not immediately available. Before taking further action, the competitor must announce the ball he wishes score if the rules permit. The player must report the facts to the committee before returning his score card; if he fails to do so, the penalty is disqualification. (Rule 20.1c)

Reporting Results

Upon completion of play, players should check their hole-by-hole scores carefully. Both the player and the marker must sign the card and return it to The Committee at the Scoreboard in a prompt manner.

Local Rules Sheet

Local rules sheets will be available each day. Please refer to these for a more extensive look at the local rules for the event.

Close of Competition

The competition shall be deemed to have closed when the trophies have been presented.

Discontinuance of Play Signals

Potentially dangerous situation: One prolonged air horn note

Other types of suspension: Three consecutive air horn notes, repeated

Resumption of play: Two short air horn notes, repeated

All participants in the 2026 Pro Am Jam are automatically entered into the Team and Individual competitions.

TEAM COMPETITION Friday & Saturday Only

Field: 52 three-man teams. The teams have been divided into 2 flights based on total team handicap.

Handicaps: Players receive 90% of the of the Aug 1st revision. Maximum adjusted handicap allowed is 18.

Format

- 36-hole Best Ball Competition
- One Gross and one Net ball counted on each hole – cannot be the same player
- Teams will have a professional paired with them each round
- Teams may use the professional's score as either gross or net on each hole; inclusion of the professional's score is not mandatory

Prizes: Golf shop certificates will be awarded to the top five places in each flight. Team flight winners will be presented the official Pro Am Jam Guitar Trophies on stage in between the Saturday night concerts.

1st Place: \$250 per player

2nd Place: \$150 per player

3rd Place: \$100 per player

4th Place: \$75 per player

5th Place: \$50 per player

INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION Thursday, Friday & Saturday

Field: All amateurs will play in the individual competition running concurrent with the team competition.

Handicaps: New this year players receive 90% of the of the Aug 1st revision. Maximum adjusted handicap allowed is 18.

Format

- 54-hole stroke play competition for overall Gross Divisions (Thursday, Friday, Saturday)
- 36-hole stroke play competition for all Net Divisions (Friday, Saturday)
- Players will be pre-flighted based on tournament handicap

1st Flight: Gross Scores only for flight prizes. Flight 1 players are still eligible to win overall net. **All other flights:** Net Scores only for flight prizes. Eligible for overall gross.

Prizes: Golf shop certificates will be awarded to the top three finishers in each flight. Overall Low Gross & Low Net Champions will receive the official Pro Am Jam Guitar Trophies.

Handicaps: New this year players receive 90% of the of the Aug 1st revision. Maximum adjusted handicap allowed is 18.

Tees: Because this division runs concurrent with the team and other individual competitions, there is only one set of tees for all amateurs.

Course set-up will be friendly!

Format

- 54-hole stroke play competition for overall Gross Divisions (Thursday, Friday, Saturday)
- 36-hole stroke play competition for all Net Divisions (Friday, Saturday)

Prizes: Golf shop certificates will be awarded to the top three finishers in Senior Gross and Senior Net. The Overall Senior Gross and Net Champions will receive Pro Am Jam Guitar Trophies.
